

General description

Nitto double-coated tape 68230 consists of a foam carrier, coated with a pressure sensitive acrylic adhesive. It can be used for a wide variety of mounting applications, mainly for touch panel mounting. We offer this product in different thicknesses which enables freedom of design.

Characteristics

Nitto 68230 is a double-coated foam tape with excellent adhesion properties on a wide range of materials such as extruded or moulded plastic parts out of PP, ABS, PA, ea, (lacquered) steel and glass.

The flexible foam carrier conforms easy to the irregularities of the substrate and provides a good impact resistance, sound dampening and sealing properties (both for dust and water).

Application

Nitto 68230 is used to mount glass and plastic parts into electronic devices, such as touch panels, speaker parts. Thanks to it's typical density it can also be used for its cushioning effect.

Application guidelines

- For optimum results, an even rub down pressure must be applied to the taped area to create the best possible adhesion between tape and the substrates.
- Remove the liner prior to usage.
- The tape should be applied to clean and dry surfaces.
- The best application conditions are obtained at a temperature between 15 °C and 40 °C.
