

Nitto D5331 is a multi-purpose tape, typically used for nameplate & membrane switches assembly, thin metals and plastic decorative foils.

The product is guaranteed to be free from defect in material and workmanship at the time of delivery and will be suitable for use for a period of 6 months thereafter, subject to the conditions set out herein.

Application guidelines

- For optimum results, an even rub down pressure must be applied to the taped area to create the best possible adhesion between tape and the substrates.
- To ensure optimal anchorage of tape to foam, attention should be paid to the lamination pressure, temperature and time.
- Remove the liner prior to usage.
- The tape should be applied to clean and dry surfaces.
- The best application conditions are obtained at a temperature between 15 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ and 40 $^{\circ}\text{C}.$
